Section C: Attached Documents

In addition to a completed nomination form (Sections A, B, personal statement/endorsement letter if nominating another university member), the following document should be included in the completed nomination package:

Blinded CV An up-to-date curriculum vitae following the template provided which should be 2 pages or less, specifically tailored to the RSI Award application. The resume should enhance the reader's knowledge of and validate the student's relevant experiences.

Consent/Release Form A signed consent form must be included. Incomplete nomination packages will not be considered.
