



NIDILRR Post-Doctoral Fellowship Opportunity at Northwestern University Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation

This NIDILRR supported Advanced Rehabilitation Research Training (AART) Program is seeking up to three post-doctoral fellows with an interest in neurologic communication and/or swallowing disorders.

This unique AART program provides two years of rigorous, in-depth research training to postdoctoral fellows with a background in communication sciences and disorders.

It is designed to prepare them for careers as independent scientists with the skills necessary to conduct their own high-quality, interdisciplinary research. Research should address the rehabilitation of acquired communication or swallowing disorders that accompany conditions such as stroke, traumatic brain injury, or Parkinson's disease.

The program emphasizes development of the Fellow's own research agenda, scholarly papers as first author, and grant submissions with potential for receipt of extramural funding.
